Notice is hereby given that pursuant to California Rules of Court, rule 2.503(e), the Court intends to provide remote electronic access to documents and case information for the above-entitled case, going forward from the date this order is effective and, as otherwise allowed by the Court, as follows:

1. Court records that are not confidential by law, ordered sealed by the Court, or otherwise specifically excepted by the Court, subject to the following conditions:

All parties filing documents in this case must provide the Court with both an original un-redacted version of the document for filing, an un-redacted courtesy copy for the Court, and a redacted version of the document for the remote electronic access. The following information shall be redacted:

- Driver license numbers
- Dates of birth
- Social security numbers
- Criminal Identification and Information and National Crime Information numbers
- Addresses and phone numbers of parties, victims, witnesses, and court personnel
- Medical or psychiatric information
- Financial information
- Account numbers
- Juror names or other juror identifying information
- Any other personal identifying information not specifically listed above

2. A list of scheduled calendar events, including the date, time and location.

Any person may submit comments to the Court regarding this notice. Comments must be submitted in writing to the Court's address set forth above or by email to ssweb@scscourt.org, and should include the identity of the commenter. Any such comments must be received by the Court no later than Tuesday, February 14, 2017, and the final determination to provide remote electronic access will be made by the Supervising Judge of the Criminal Division.


