We Are Committed To Achieving Equality And Justice For All

*Santa Clara County Superior Court Equality and Social Justice Committee's
Public Service Announcement Available For Viewing Now*

In June 2020, responding to recent events, the Chief Justice of the California Supreme Court, Tani Cantil-Sakauye, called on the judiciary to “continue to remove barriers to access and fairness, to address conscious and unconscious bias – and yes, racism.” Our Court answered the Chief Justice’s call to recognize that we bear a responsibility to act and advocate for equality and social justice. The newly formed Equality and Social Justice Committee of the Santa Clara County Superior Court created the following video public service announcement to demonstrate our belief that all of us, regardless of gender, race, color, creed, sexual orientation, or identity – deserve justice.
