**GENERAL ORDER RE: IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF
AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 68115 BY CHAIR
OF JUDICIAL COUNCIL**


Exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the March, 30, 2020 Order (“Order”) of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council of California, issued in response to the April 27, 2020 request for an emergency order made by the Superior Court of Santa Clara County (“Court”), this Court **HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. For purposes of computing time for filing papers with the Court under Code of Civil Procedure sections 12 and 12a, the time from April 29, 2020 to May 29, 2020, inclusive, is deemed holidays because the emergency conditions described in the Order have substantially interfered with the public’s ability to file papers in a court facility on those dates (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(4));

2. For purposes of computing time under Welfare and Institutions Code sections 313, 315, 334, 631, 632, 637, and 657, the time from April 29, 2020, to May 29, 2020, inclusive, is deemed holidays because the emergency conditions described in the Order prevent the court from conducting proceedings and accepting filings on those dates as necessary to satisfy these deadlines (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(5)).

THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE April 29, 2020.
