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SUPERIOR COURT SEEKS APPLICANTS TO PROVIDE TRAFFIC VIOLATOR SCHOOL (TVS) SERVICES TO OFFENDERS REFERRED BY THE COURT

The Superior Court of California, County of Santa Clara (Court) is seeking a provider of traffic violator school (TVS) services. The Request for Proposals (RFP) may be found on the Court's website at www.sccsuperiorcourt.org/news/rfp.htm.

The purpose of this RFP is to provide the Court with competitive bids in order to select the most efficient and cost effective provider of TVS services to defendants referred by the Court, pursuant to California Vehicle Code, at multiple locations though the County of Santa Clara in both a traditional classroom setting and online program through the internet concluding with a final examination.

Proposals are being solicited to provide TVS services for the period April 1, 2009 through March 31, 2012. Only proposals for an all-inclusive contract that addresses all costs associated with TVS services will be considered. A total fee bid for each year is required.

The Court intends to negotiate with the applicant whose proposal best serves the needs of the Court at a reasonable cost. The Court reserves the right to reject all proposals.

Costs incurred by applicants in responding to this RFP are entirely the responsibility of the applicants.

A potential provider must submit an RFP to provide TVS services for the entire geographical area of the County of Santa Clara. The Court retains the right to permit defendants to attend traffic school classes outside of the County of Santa Clara.
