*Implementation of emergency relief authorized pursuant
to Govt. Code 68115 by Chair of Judicial Council*

SAN JOSÉ, California (March 16, 2020): On March 16, 2020, Presiding Judge Deborah A. Ryan signed an order that any judge of the Superior Court may extend by not more than 21 days the duration of any temporary restraining order that would otherwise expire from March 16, 2020 through April 5, 2020.

**GENERAL ORDER RE: IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF
AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 68115 BY CHAIR
OF JUDICIAL COUNCIL**

Exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the March 13, 2020 Order ("Order") of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council of California, issued in response to the March 13, 2020 request for an emergency order made by the Superior Court of Santa Clara County ("Court"), this Court HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

Any judge of the Court may extend by not more than 21 days the duration of any temporary restraining order that would otherwise expire from March 16, 2020, through April 5, 2020 because the emergency condition described in the Order prevented the Court from conducting proceedings to determine whether a permanent order should be entered (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(7));
