**SUPERIOR COURT OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

**FAMILY DIVISION ORDER RE: TEMPORARY APPROVAL OF SUPERVISED  
VISITATION USING REMOTE OR VIRTUAL TECHNOLOGY**

The Court HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Since March 4, 2020, the State of California has been in a State of Emergency related to COVID-19.

2. On March 16, 2020, the County of Santa Clara Public Health Officer issued an order directing all individuals living in Santa Clara County to shelter at their place of residence except that they may leave to provide or receive certain essential services or engage in certain essential activities and work for essential businesses and governmental services to mitigate the spread of COVID-19.


3. Protection of public health and safety in connection with this situation has resulted or is expected to result in significant interference with Superior Court services and proceedings.

4. Under these circumstances, and absent court authorization for an alternative form of visitation, parents subject to orders for professionally-supervised visitation are unable to obtain in-person services and may not have any contact with their children.

1           5.       Court ordered supervised visitation for parents and children ensures child safety  
2 and is in the best interest of children. Accordingly, the Court authorizes agency providers of  
3 professionally-supervised visitation to offer supervised visitation services using remote or virtual  
4 technology in a manner that conforms to Standard of Judicial Administration 5.20 of the  
5 California Rules of Court. Remote or virtual supervised visitation may occur in lieu of in-person  
6 services in cases in which professionally-supervised visitation has been ordered.

7           THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY AND SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT  
8 UNTIL SANTA CLARA COUNTY IS NO LONGER SUBJECT TO A SHELTER IN PLACE  
9 ORDER.
