**GENERAL ORDER RE: IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF
AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 68115 BY CHAIR
OF JUDICIAL COUNCIL**

Exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the June 1, 2020 Order (“Order”) of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council of California, issued in response to the May 28 and June 1, 2020 requests for an emergency order made by the Superior Court of Santa Clara County (“Court”), this Court **HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. For purposes of computing time for filing papers with the Court under Code of Civil Procedure sections 12 and 12a, June 1, 2020 is deemed a holiday because the emergency conditions described in the Order substantially interfered with the public’s ability to file papers in a court facility on those dates (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(4));


2. For purposes of computing time for filing unlawful detainer papers with the Court under Code of Civil Procedure sections 12 and 12a, the period from June 1, 2020, to June 30, 2020, inclusive, is deemed holidays because the emergency conditions described in the Order will substantially interfere with the public’s ability to file papers in a court facility on those dates (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(4));

1 3. For purposes of computing time under Welfare and Institutions Code sections
2 313, 315, 334, 631, 632, 637, and 657, for the period from June 1, 2020, to June 30, 2020,
3 inclusive, is deemed holidays as the emergency conditions described in the Order prevent the
4 Court from conducting proceedings and accepting filings on those dates as necessary to satisfy
5 these deadlines (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(5));

6 4. In cases in which the original or previously extended statutory deadline would
7 expire from June 16, 2020, to July 17, 2020, inclusive, the time period provided in section 1382
8 of the Penal Code for the holding of a criminal trial is extended for not more than 30 days (Gov.
9 Code, § 68115(a)(10)).

10 THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE June 1, 2020.
